The Janitorial-Housekeeping position is responsible for keeping the property in a safe condition and adhering to safety standards and operating equipment in a safe and responsible manner.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The primary responsibility is to keep the facility's interior common areas clean and in orderly condition daily by sweeping and mopping floors, dusting and polish furniture, cleaning glass windows, and emptying trash containers.
- Moving dumpsters for trash removal and cleaning trash rooms.
- Overall cleaning of vacant apartments.
- Setting up tables and chairs in community room for activities.
- Other duties may include assisting Maintenance Worker II in performing maintenance activities on an as needed basis especially during apartment turnovers.
